Develop a question
OR
Articulate the problem/need

WHAT

Select a strategy or tool that is worth trialling.

HOW?

Plan activities that embed the strategy or tool, and elicit the evidence of learning.

Plan an approach to collect data.

WHEN

Plan for implementation.
Plan for reflection, review and evaluation
